








Between two streets that start together only to later diverge in distance and height, swallowing up the remains of a small half-collapsed house between dividing walls, we have to build a house for a new family. The regulations are open: we choose to create a knot to connect the complexity of elements, streets, and forms that converge in this dense part of the urban fabric. Home Projects Products Folders



The double road alignment to be followed makes it possible to break up the rigid volumetry of a building between the dividing walls into two parts: the garden and the house. And the difference in height between the two streets that confront each other allows for the neat leaning of one volume against the other, while the road access is arranged underneath the house.
